

# Assistant Professorship in Business Administration

The Department of Border Region Studies invites applications for a position as Assistant Professor in Business Administration/Global Business Economics. The position is located in Sønderborg. The position is vacant from 01.03.2014 or soon thereafter and has a time limit of three years.

## Job description

The recently established [Danfoss Center of Global Business](#) at [the Department of Border Region Studies](#), Faculty of Business & Social Sciences, University of Southern Denmark, Campus Sønderborg, seeks to fill one Assistant Professor position. The vision of the Danfoss Center of Global Business is to build a unique high profile, high quality research and teaching pole in the field of global business. The candidate is expected to conduct research of international standards documented through publications in international journals. Strong quantitative skills are an asset.

In terms of research and teaching, one or several areas related to business administration (JEL-code M; AOM in analogy to the Academy of Management division) should be of interest to the candidate, in particular:

- International Management (AOM)
- (Strategic) Operations Management (AOM)
- Technology and Innovation Management (AOM)
- Business Policy and Strategy (AOM)
- B2B Marketing
- Value chain management

The position involves research, teaching in undergraduate and graduate programmes, and participation in administrative tasks. The position also includes thesis supervision on bachelor and master levels, and contributing to the further development of the department. The candidate is expected to be a visible, active participant in the department's daily activities, in addition to being willing to engage in collaboration across [the department's Research Groups](#). Favorable tax-schemes exist for non-Danish researchers.

## Qualification requirements

- The applicant holds a PhD or equivalent in business administration/economics with a specialisation in one of the above areas.

- International peer-reviewed publications related to the above mentioned fields.

### **Application, salary, etc.**

Appointment to the position will be in accordance with the salary agreement between the Ministry of Finance and the Danish Confederation of Professional Associations.

An application must include:

- Detailed CV
- Certificates/Diplomas (Master and PhD degree)
- Information on teaching experience or other forms of knowledge communication
- Complete list of publications, indicating which publications are most relevant for the position
- Up to 5 of the most relevant publications. Please upload a pdf for each publication, if the publication has been co-authored, co-author statements must be a part of this pdf
- Research and publication plan for the next 3 years
- References

Applications will be assessed by an assessment committee. The committee may request additional information, and if so, it is the responsibility of the applicant to provide the necessary material.

When the assessment committee has submitted its report, the applicant will receive the part of the evaluation that concerns him/her.

Applications that are incomplete with regard to the above requirements will not be assessed by the committee.

The University encourages all interested persons to apply, regardless of age, gender, religious affiliation or ethnic background.

As part of the overall assessment of the applicant's qualifications, an interview may be applied.
